How Many Letters Are In Goodbye?

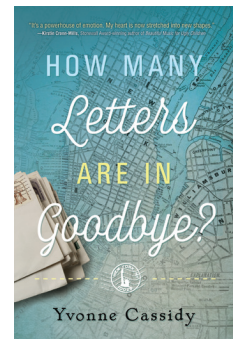
