Crimes committed against people because of their race, ethnicity, sexual orientation, or religion have become common in the United States. According to the FBI, more than six thousand such crimes were committed in 2016 alone. Hate crimes can range from vandalism, such as the desecration of headstones in a Jewish cemetery, to mass shootings, such as the 2015 murders of nine African Americans attending church services in Charleston, South Carolina. Although many laws have been written to prevent and prosecute hate crimes, experts agree that stopping such offenses from occurring will not be easy.

Black Lives Matter was born in July 2013 after a jury exonerated the killer of an unarmed black youth named Trayvon Martin. Since that time it has become known as a formidable, often controversial, civil rights movement that seeks equality and fair treatment of black citizens by law enforcement and by society as a whole.

for physical evidence such as hair. The victim is also searched for internal and external injuries, which are documented with photographs and samples. All of this evidence is collected and stored in what is usually called a rape kit. These kits can provide powerful evidence in investigations of sexual violence. However, experts estimate that hundreds of thousands of these rape kits have never been tested in some cases, police departments collect the kits but do not send them away for DNA evidence. In others, the kits are sent away for testing that is not completed. Advocacy groups such as End the Backlog, which is run by the nonprofit Joyful Heart Foundation, ask for mandatory testing of these kits. The project has succeeded in raising funds to test unexamined rape kits.

SEXUAL VIOLENCE IN PRISONS
The United States has the world's largest population of incarcerated people. More than two million people are held in jails, prisons, juvenile correctional facilities, immigrant detention facilities, and other types of confinement. Prison inmates face very little power in their daily lives. People in prison are especially vulnerable to sexual violence by other inmates and by prison staff. The Bureau of Justice Statistics believes that more than 200,000 prison inmates a year are victims of sexual violence. People who are held in immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) detention facilities are also targeted for sexual violence and abuse. In 2010, the immigrant, or non-citizen, collected hundreds of accounts of sexual violence in these facilities. Many of these accounts involved sexual assault by guards and threats to harm someone else. Advocates believe that because many people held in immigration detention are afraid to report their abuse, the actual number of sexual violence incidents is much higher.

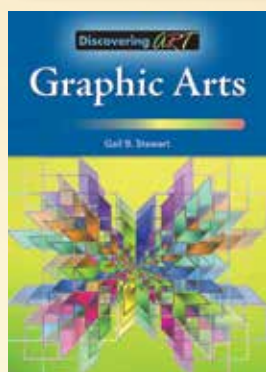
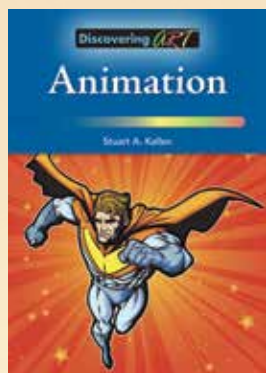
Dedicated until 1919 Eisner was always a rebel who challenged the norms that defined comic books. In the 1940s comic strip *The Spirit*, he incorporated the bold, angular, weird colors, and esoteric shapes of the Romantic and Expressionist periods. This style represented a marked difference from the art of other comic book artists of the time, who were more concerned with the traditional comic book format. In 1979 Eisner took notice in an entirely new direction with the publication of the graphic novel *A Contract with God* and other *Saramita Stories*. Unlike the comic books of the time, which were mostly created around superheroes and villains, Eisner's graphic novel featured four stories that touched on the subject of the human condition in New York City during the 1930s.

In *A Contract with God*, Eisner sought to create a work of art, which can be defined as a written work of writing artists work. Eisner created long, character-driven stories set on a fictional street he called *Doopie Avenue*. Eisner described heartbreak, hope, compassion, and crime as it was experienced by real people living through economic turmoil caused by the Great Depression.

Although the term *graphic novel* was first used in 1964, *A Contract with God* has come to define the form. Although a 28-page comic book might be seen as an episode of a television show in which all the problems are solved in five minutes, graphic novels, which can run to 120 pages, are comparable to full-length feature films in which stories unfold at a leisurely pace. In *A Contract with God*, Eisner's intricate stories are told with de-

His reputation—as a negotiator, salesman, reality show host, and builder of glittering skyscrapers, golf courses, and casinos—set him apart from all of the other candidates. His campaign set him apart as well. He commanded public and media attention via Twitter. He uttered what many considered to be outrageous statements—offending some Americans with his comments about women, Mexican immigrants, and Muslims, and horrifying others with his support for seemingly discredited theories. He also spoke about the need for jobs and recapturing a way of life that seemed, to many of his supporters, to be slipping away. In Trump's campaign appearances, interviews, speeches, debates, and tweets, the recurring themes were: anger, frustration, and disillusionment—a world and a way of life gone awry.

Donald Trump broke all of the rules of traditional political campaigns. Few, even in his own party, thought he would win. But he did. *Donald Trump: 45th US President* explores Trump's early life, his formative years, his career, and the campaign that brought him into office as America's 45th president.
